Monday Mid-Day Program

Our next Monday Mid-Day Program will be on April 8th at 11:00 a.m. with our guest speaker Rev. Dr. Horace Douty with the topic "The Waters of Rockbridge". The program will be followed by a light lunch and fellowship. Rev. Dr. Horace Douty was raised in the Timber Ridge area of Rockbridge. He graduated from Washington and Lee University and later earned his doctorate from Seminary. In 1957 he was ordained a Presbyterian pastor and served in active ministry for more than 65 years. After living away from Rockbridge for half a century, he moved back in 2004. He and his wife, Ellen, live near Lexington and they have four grown children between them. Rev. Douty has authored several pieces for The Rockbridge Historical Society titled "Proceedings of the Rockbridge Historical Society". His books volume I and II are entitled "History Lessons from a Country Church". He prepares and presents weekly videos for YouTube featuring nature, history lessons, sermons and prayers.

On April 22nd Leah C. from Dept. of Wildlife Resources. The title of her presentation is "From the Rare to the Abundant - Furbearers of Virginia". She will talk about all furbearers, including some trapping information, as well as summarize some recent/current/ upcoming projects on the Dept. of Wildlife Resources. She began her work spotted skunks, gray foxes, muskrats, and weasels. She is the statewide Furbearer Biologist with DWR in late January 2024. Prior to this, she worked with the Dept. of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) as a state zoologist, working on various projects, including surveys for rare pollinators and freshwater mussels. She has lived and worked in Virginia for 12 years, with most of that time in Warren County. Her background is in wildlife population ecology and has trapped mammals ranging from mice to wolves.
