Dear Old Providence Family,

Let me start by saying a big "THANK YOU" to all those who worked so hard at our Vacation Bible School! What a wonderful week it was with approximately 65 children as well as a great adult class. VBS week is a big investment. There's no doubt that it requires much time and energy. However, that investment is worth our efforts. If you doubt that, consider the following story.

Each night, throughout the week of VBS, we began with an opening assembly that involved a short skit, singing, and of course, saying our pledges to the American Flag, the Christian Flag, and to the Bible. The Pledge to the Bible says "I pledge allegiance to the Bible, God's Holy Word. I will make it a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path and I will hide its word in my heart that I might not sin against God." During the pledge someone would hold up a copy of God's Word. One night, after the pledge to the Bible was complete, one of the children said to one of our teachers "Do you have one of those at home?" Puzzled, the teacher responded with something like "Do you mean a Bible? Yes." Then the child asked, "Do you read it?" to which the teacher also said, "Yes, of course." The child then went on to express a desire to have a copy of the Bible.

Thankfully, a couple in our church made an incredibly generous donation of purchasing enough Bibles so that every child could take a copy home. Even so, this story points to a reality you may not have previously considered. There was a time when Vacation Bible School's purpose was to *further* educate children about God's Word, the key word there being "further". These days the reality is that many of the children who attend our Vacation Bible School have little to no education about God's Word to begin with. Many of them have never been exposed to the basic truths of Scripture, and certainly aren't a regular part of church anywhere. As a result, we should keep in mind how important VBS really is. As Galatians 6:9 says, we must not grow weary in doing good. And to that end, we must remember to pray for the salvation of the children who attended, and for their parents, as well.

Again, thank you so much for all your hard work. Take comfort in the fact that God is sovereign over all things, including the children and adults who were able to attend VBS. Be encouraged that the Lord allowed, and continues to allow us, to be part of His grand redemptive plan.
