Dear Old Providence Family,

Happy New Year! It's hard to believe, but 2023 has come and gone and 2024 is here. How can this be? I don't even feel like I've gotten used to writing "2023", and now 2024 is here? Life moving by so fast only points to the fact that the passing of time is inevitable. And not only that, we can't speed time up or slow it down. Even so, we can ponder what we will do with the time we have. As you think about the year ahead, what will you do this year? Do you have plans for something you'd like to accomplish? Maybe you've even made a "New Year's Resolution" (and by the time you get this newsletter you might have already broken it)! While there's nothing wrong with making plans and being prepared, let me encourage you to remember what the Bible says about how we should plan for 2024 and life in general.

James 4: 13-16 says: **13** Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." 14 Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. 15 Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." 16 As it is, you boast in your arrogant schemes. All such boasting is evil.

Don't miss what God has revealed in His Word. In this passage both the brevity of life and the scope of our knowledge is revealed. And what shall we take away from what has been revealed? We need the Lord, that's what! It's just that simple. As James wrote, if we were to proceed into the future as if we were the masters of our own destiny, with no regard for God, we become evil boasters. Instead, as verse 15 says, our focus should be on God and our desire should be for His will to be done. It all comes down to the simple truth that what God wants for you is what's best for you. And you can find what God wants for you through His Word. This truth applies to all of us, no matter what circumstances we are facing.

As you enter into 2024, do so with the full assurance that God will be with you no matter what you face. Hold on to the promise Jesus made in Matthew 28:20 when He said *"I am with you always, to the end of the age."* And remember, the only way to really have a "Happy New Year" is to rejoice in Christ. If you make New Year's resolutions, make sure that you are seeking God's will and relying on His strength alone to do what it is you have set out to accomplish.
