Dear Old Providence Family,

As we enter the month of July there is excitement in the air with the start of VBS just around the corner. But some significant events in the ARP Church have just finished with opportunities moving forward as well. June is the timing of the General Synod Meeting at Bonclarken where the denominational business is conducted. What was exciting and a little different this year was the World Focus Conference of missions, outreach, and agencies of the ARP just after Synod.

It is with thanksgiving that I can report that the business of the denomination went well with several judicial issues, several memorials (similar to motions) and many greetings and encouragements from fraternal denominations of the ARP all being received and/or debated and actually concluded in near record time.

Opening worship of World Focus was held Thursday night with a husband-and-wife music team soon to enter the mission field in the United Kingdom leading music, and Derek preaching on the cost of either going or supporting missions being small, compared to the sacrifice of Christ on the Cross for us. Thursday afternoon was full of discussions for Joanie and me in meeting people who are currently on the mission field in Africa, Europe and the Far East, and church planters throughout the U.S. and Canada.

Talking to these missionaries and evangelists was encouraging for us. Two specific ties to Old Providence were talking with, and getting our picture taken with, Rebecca in the Germany Booth, and hearing how encouraging it is for the Cochrans in the UK when they frequently receive letters from the Women of Old Providence Church. We are hopeful that the Cochrans may get up to OP sometime, possibly in the month of August to worship with us one Sunday.

You may ask how we can continue to grow in our support or even go ourselves into the mission field from Old Providence. We will be exploring this opportunity in Sunday Evening Study, sponsored by the Evangelism and Outreach Committee, where we will be studying the concept of what it means to serve as senders for those in the mission field. This study will utilize the book *Serving as Senders Today* by Neal Pirolo and meet at 5:30 p.m. Sunday evenings starting July 23rd for about seven weeks in the Fellowship Hall. Although we will build on previous weeks, missing one or two classes should not stop you from attending. It is not necessary to read the book, but it is welcomed. We will have light snacks and plan on this being a **multi-generational** class.
