Dear Old Providence Family,

I've even been told that some of your largest snows come in March. But even so, the changing of seasons is inevitable, and with Spring comes Easter and celebrating Christ's resurrection. Let us all glory in the tangible reminders of the season that point to the newness of life. But in addition, let us turn our minds to the passion of our Savior's crucifixion, the glory of His resurrection, and what these things really mean for us.

God's Word tells us in I Corinthians 15: 16-19 that *"If the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins. Those, then, who have fallen asleep in Christ have also perished. If we have put our hope in Christ for this life only, we should be pitied more than anyone."* Do you get what those verses mean? The proof of Christianity and our hope for the future are both founded upon Christ's resurrection from the dead, which points to our resurrection in Him. This is true to the point that, as verse 19 says, if Jesus was not raised from the dead then we are to be pitied above all others. Why? Because if Jesus is not alive today then our entire faith is a lie. But praise be to God, Jesus is alive and His promise of life to those who trust in Him is sure!

The risen Jesus being alive today, and the promise of eternal life for those who trust in Him, is what sets Christianity apart from every other religion on earth. We do not follow the ancient teachings of fake prophets or adhere to the lofty philosophies of mere men, long in the grave. We serve the risen Savior! Jesus is alive. And the promise made to those who trust in Him is the promise of life eternal. God's Word continues in I Corinthians 15: 20-22 by saying *"But as it is, Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead also comes through a man. For just as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive." Let these words encourage you as you consider Christ's sacrifice and glory. Also, let these truths encourage you to commit anew to being a regular part of the life at Old Providence, and certainly plan to worship with us this Easter.
